

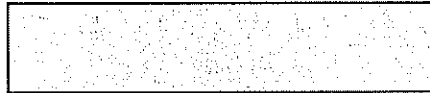

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order continues and provides funding for one Public Service Coordinator I position established by Financial Order 004643 F8 in fiscal year 2017-18 and continued by Financial Order 005114 F9 in fiscal year 2018-19. The position began on October 23, 2017 and will end on August 23, 2019. This position is necessary to implement and maintain regionalization efforts pursuant to 20-A MRSA Chapter 123 School Management and Leadership Centers and coordinate grant opportunities under 20-A MRSA Chapter 114-A Fund for the Efficient Delivery of Educational Services. This position provides technical advice and recommendations to the department's Regionalization Team in the development and implementation of policies and procedures for these programs; provides technical advice to stakeholders involved in regionalization activities; serves on the regionalization application review team; and develops and recommends school funding initiatives relating to regionalization funding, programs and activities. Pursuant to 20-A MRSA Chapter 15689 subsection 9, the position will be funded with a transfer from All Other to Personal Services.

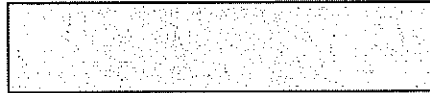

This position coordinates the development and implementation of policies and procedures for these programs with other Department of Education leadership staff; administers several small programs and annual activities as assigned by the Commissioner; and directly manages and oversees operations, support or administrative functions of these programs and activities. 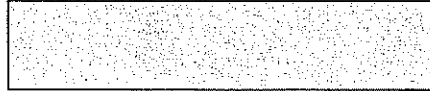

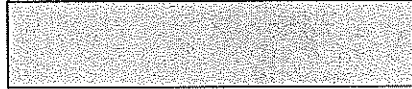

Statement of Fact

This financial order will allot a portion of the anticipated unencumbered balance forward to purchase a replacement electrofishing control box for the department's 16 foot electrofishing boat. This piece of equipment regulates and controls the electrical output such that it ensures the safety of the operators as well as reduces the mortality on non-target fish species. Failure to approve this financial order will have a detrimental impact on the department's ability to ensure the safety of its biologists as well as decrease the department's nuisance fish rapid response capacity.
