
ORDERED,

That the State Controller increase allotment in account 013-10A-0143-03, Federal Project Grants, by \$33,160 in the Capital Expenditures category for the purpose of purchasing two Series UF V - Ultralow Temperature Freezers with Climate-Neutral Refrigerants to store and preserve samples collected from individuals tested for COVID-19; and,

that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2020", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order will increase allotment by \$33,160 to purchase two Series UF V - Ultralow Temperature Freezers with Climate-Neutral Refrigerants to store and preserve samples collected from individuals tested for COVID-19 for the Health and Environmental Testing Laboratory. New grant funding from the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Response grant provides funding for these freezers. The Lab does not have enough capacity to store COVID-19 samples in their existing freezers.



Statement of Fact

This financial order provides allotment to purchase a new KingFisher Flex Nucleic Acid extractor platform to test for COVID-19. This platform will address the current backlog of COVID-19 test samples. This instrument has not only been approved for testing COVID-19 samples but can also be used to test for other infectious diseases, such as influenza. Funding is provided by a new Public Health Emergency Preparedness Response grant.
