§12053. Unlawful use of licensed dog training area

- 1. Unlawful use of licensed dog training area. The following provisions apply to licensed dog training areas.
 - A. A person may not hunt on a licensed dog training area licensed under section 12052 except that the owner of the land being used as a licensed dog training area may hunt wild animals and wild birds on the training area to the extent permitted by this Part.  - B. A person may not do any of the following on a dog training area licensed and posted in accordance with section 12052 except as provided in section 12052:
 - (1) Train a dog;
 - (2) Hold a field trial;
 - (3) Enter the area accompanied by a dog; or

 - **2. Penalties.** The following penalties apply to violations of this section.
